



MLA Style for Electronic Literary Resources

I. CITING ARTICLES FROM GALILEO DATABASES

Most citations include these pieces of information:

Author's name (if given)	Library where accessed: Georgia Perimeter College Lib.
Article title "in quotations"	Clarkston, GA.
Source of the article (journal title) <u>underlined</u>	Date when you read the article online.
Volume, date, and issue information	Web address of online service. Example:
Database name underlined	< http://www.ebscohost.com >.

II. CITING ARTICLES FROM LITERATURE RESOURCE CENTER

Use the "Source Citation" information at the end of the article to write your citation. You will need:

Author's name (if given)	Library where accessed: Georgia Perimeter College Lib.
Article title "in quotations"	Clarkston, GA.
Source of the article (journal title) <u>underlined</u>	Date when you read the article online.
Volume, date, and issue information	Web address of online service. Example:
Database name underlined	< http://www.ebscohost.com >.

III. CITING ELECTRONIC BOOKS (eBOOKS) FROM NETLIBRARY

You will need: Author's name, title of book underlined, place of publication, publisher, publication date, database name, where accessed, date accessed, and web address in <pointy brackets>.

EXAMPLE

Wells, Gail. The Tillamook: A Created Forest Comes of Age. Cornwallis, OR: Oregon State P, 1999. NetLibrary. Georgia Perimeter College Lib., Clarkston, GA. 29 Aug. 2003 <<http://www.netLibrary.com>>.

IV. CITING ARTICLES AND WEB SITES FROM THE INTERNET

You will need: Author's name (if given), article title "in quotations," title of main web site underlined, date of publication, name of source with publication date or date of last revision, last date of access, web address (URL) of the site in <pointy brackets>.
