- (a) Students with credit for MATH 1101 (Introduction to Mathematical Modeling) may substitute MATH 1101 for MATH 1001.
- (b) The following courses are recommended for students transferring to **Georgia State's** B.A. in Foreign Language Program and planning to apply for acceptance into the Master of International Business Program:
  - MATH 1111 in Area A
  - FREN, GRMN, or SPAN in Area B and F
  - FREN, GRMN, SPAN, or PHIL 2020 in Area C
  - Two 4-hour laboratory science sequence courses in Area D
  - MATH 1431 in Area D
  - ECON 2105\* in Area E or F
  - ACCT 2101\* and 2102\* and ECON 2106\* in Area F
  - Additional languages are recommended.
- (c) Foreign language options include Arabic, Chinese, French, German, Italian, Japanese, Korean, Portuguese, Russian, and Spanish.
- (d) The following courses are recommended for students transferring to **Kennesaw's** B.A. in Modern Language and Culture with a concentration in Applied Business Program:
  - FREN or SPAN in Area B, C, and F
  - ACCT 2101\*, BUSA 2106\*, and ECON 2106\* in Area F
- (e) Students with credit for CSCI 1300 (Introduction to Computer Science) prior to fall 2011 may substitute CSCI 1300 for CSCI 1100. Students may NOT receive credit for both CSCI 1100 and CSCI 1300.
- (f) A student may not receive credit for Foreign Language 1001 if the student has had two years of that language in high school.
