**Important Notes:**

- (a) Students with credit for MATH 1101 (Introduction to Mathematical Modeling) may substitute MATH 1101 for MATH 1001.
- (b) Foreign language options include Arabic, Chinese, French, German, Italian, Japanese, Korean, Portuguese, Russian, and Spanish.
- (c) Students with credit for CSCI 1300 (Introduction to Computer Science) prior to fall 2011 may substitute CSCI 1300 for CSCI 1100. Students may NOT receive credit for both CSCI 1100 and CSCI 1300.
- (d) Students choosing a literature course for Area F should choose an area of study (world, British, or American) that differs from their literature area of study in Area C.

Before completing Area F, transferring students should consult the transferring institution's catalog. It is recommended that Professional Writing students interested in a Journalism track choose at least one COMM course. Students interested in a Creative Writing track should choose at least one ENGL class.

Georgia State University transfers: If you have not taken a foreign language in Area B or C, you must do so in Area F.
