He was honored to serve for two years as the Chair of the Technology in Math Education Committee of the American Mathematical Association of Two Year Colleges. He is also an active member of the National Council of Teachers of Mathematics.

Educators around the world have embraced Wilson's award-winning mathematics textbooks which focus on teaching mathematics in the context of real world applications. His textbooks Finite Mathematics and Applied Calculus, Brief Calculus, Finite Mathematics, and Applied Calculus are available through Cengage Learning. Three new books (Algebra and Trigonometry, Precalculus, and College Algebra) will be available by 2011.

Wilson regularly gives keynote presentations and workshops to inspire educators. He is founder and President of Make It Real Learning Company, a company which creates math worksheets which address the question, "When am I ever going to use this?"
