

Interpreting Music: The Dos and Don'ts

TARGET AUDIENCE: Advanced ASL students, Interpreting students, and Professional Interpreters who want to learn more about artistic interpreting Workshop will be presented in Spoken English.

DESCRIPTION: This workshop will encourage participants to analyze the meaning of the song and interpret the meaning while still conveying the mood and style of the music. Participants will view examples of interpreted and performed music and will learn the difference between them and when to “interpret” and when to “perform” music. Participants will work on translations of music and will interpret music in front of other participants to receive feedback on their work (on a voluntary basis).

PARTICIPANT REQUIREMENTS: Each participant should bring a personal CD player with headsets, a CD with one song of their choice, and typed lyrics to that song.
